## Sanlorenzo at the Palma International Boat Show 2022

*At the Mediterranean boat show, design innovations take centre stage  
Featuring both a crossover and an asymmetrical model*

*Press release, 21st April 2022* - Sanlorenzo docks at the **Palma International Boat Show**, the opening event of the nautical season in the Mediterranean, which takes place this year **from the 28th April to 1st May**. Over 600 vessels will decorate the seafront of Palma de Mallorca for a boat show that attracts professionals and boating enthusiasts from all over Europe.

At the kermesse, Sanlorenzo presents the **SX76 crossover** and the **asymmetrical SL90A**, two models that encapsulate **the shipyard's unique ability to grasp and anticipate evolving trends**, becoming an inspirational model for the entire sector.

**SX76** is an example of the crossover line, a synthesis between the classic motor yacht with flying bridge and the explorer type. A boat designed for lovers of the sea, the **SX76 privileges navigation** via solutions that maximise the indoor/outdoor connection, such as large open spaces and large glass surfaces.

At the Palma Boat Show, asymmetry is back in the spotlight with the **SL90A**, a model that represented a great design challenge given the vessel's small size compared to sister ships. Thanks to its innovative layout, the SL90A maintains the starboard side of the boat only and eliminates the port side, which then extends up to the roof of the structure, **amplifying the salon on the main deck**. The **full-height lateral windows**, which on the port side directly overlook the sea, offer a unique panoramic view, creating a direct and continuous connection with the outside world.

The asymmetrical configuration enables a layout with the **owner's cabin and main deck saloon at the same level**, a solution normally found on larger yachts. The owner's cabin has dedicated access to the bow area, while the **fly and bow area are connected to each other** and have a large sundeck integrated into the full-beam superstructure.

SL90A is the result of a stylistic synthesis that **prioritises lightness and a great balance of volumes**, a yacht with **"One Way" glazing** that on the outside is chromatically similar to the hull and dematerialises the appearance of voids, giving a sense of cleanliness and aesthetic continuity.
